2017 NOTES:

- State Regional Hurricane Evacuation Study (Ops Scenario, 2015 projections @ 20 sf per person)
- Pinellas Hope facility slated to go to Ross Norton for Tropical Storms and Largo for Hurricanes
- Safe Harbor is now located in a Level B evacuation and will evacuate to Pinellas Park up to a Level C evacuation, after which it will need to go to Lealman Innovation Academy now starting at Level D Evacuation.
- Sanderlin ES, Largo HS, Pinellas Park HS, and Gibbs HS require further capacity analysis study. Palm Harbor University HS and Largo HS need to be surveyed by FL DOH and PC Animal Services for use as alternate sites in Level E events.
- First Baptist Church St. Petersburg is under review for use as a shelter for Recommended Tropical Storm Evacuations.
- Due to the 2016 Storm Surge analysis some shelter locations usage have been impacted.
- Ten (10) square feet will be used for any Level E evacuation.
